Part 2: Spectating Vs. Participating

Ecclesiastes 9:10 - Why are you here? Are you a help or hindrance?

I. Do Not Ask What Your <u>Church</u> Can Do For You, But What You Can Do For Your <u>Church</u>

- A. Offer to be a help rather than waiting to be asked. Show initiative!
- B. You should <u>want</u> to <u>see</u> your church blessed as much as you <u>want</u> to <u>be</u> blessed.
- C. Never wait for <u>others</u> to do what you <u>can do</u> right now.

II. Watchers Never Work And Workers Never Watch

- A. Watch out for people who always have a **problem** when you do what they **don't** want to do.
- B. Never base what you are <u>willing</u> to do on what someone else does. Because God will not base your <u>blessings</u> on them either.
- C. Workers must never be **deterred** by watchers.

III. Never Forget, This Is God's Work

Colossians 3:23

- A. Your **reward** comes from **Him**.
- B. Do not look for a **reward** from man that only God can **provide**.
- C. Never base what you **do** for the Church/God on what you can **get**.
- D. If you will be good to God's **church**, He will be good to **you**.
