Introduction

- Discern means to come to know, recognize, detect, or perceive.
- ❖ Discern also means to see or know the difference between a thing or situation.
- ❖ Discernment enables one to distinguish between right and wrong.
- To see or understand the difference between God's voice and the voice of others.
- ❖ The Greek word for knowledge "GNOSIS" = knowing through recognition, study, or experience.

How can we discern the Voice of God?

I. Through His Word

Psalm 119:105

There are some prerequisites to understanding God's Word:

A. You should be a **Christian**.

Romans 8:14

B. You must be **wise**.

Ephesians 5:15-17

C. You must be willing to **obey**.

D. You must be willing to pray and <u>wait</u>.

I John 5:14; Daniel 10:12-14

E. You must be willing to give up some of your comforts.

Acts 20:22-24

II. Through The Inner Prompting Of The Inner Spirit.

John 14:16-17; I Corinthians 6:19

- A. The Spirit **<u>guides</u>** us into truth.
- B. We must be willing to be <u>led</u>.

III. Through The Wise Counsel and Qualities Of Other People

- B. Valuable friendships are **nourishing**.

- A. Peace is not the absence of **chaos**.
- B. Peace can be a military **fortress**.
