## Introduction

- i. Discern means to come to know or recognize mentally.
- ii. Discern also means to see or know the difference -1 John 4:1, Matthew 7:15 -Message
- iii. We must mentally recognize the voice of God.
- iv. To see or understand the difference between God's voice and other voices.
- v. The Greek word for knowledge means: knowing through recognition, study, or experience.
- I. God's Voice Can Interrupt Our **PLANS**.

Acts 9:1-6

- A. Saul desired to persecute the **CHRISTIANS**.
- B. God wanted to make Saul a CHRISTIAN.
- C. We can be changed with one **CONVERSATION**.
- II. God's Voice Can Be Heard When We're In The Right **POSITION**.

II Pet. 1:18

- A. The people knew the direction from which the voice **CAME**.
- B. The people could discern the voice of God because they were **CONSECRATED**.
- III. God's Voice Can Be Heard Even When We Are On Our "PATMOS." Rev. 1:9-11
  - A. John was in a state of **INCARCERATION** and **ISOLATION**.
  - B. In spite of his isolation, God's voice gave **INSPIRATION**.
- IV. God Speaks In Ways That Are Not Always PREDICTABLE.

I Kings 19:11-13

- A. We should never seek to limit God's **APPROACH**.
- B. We must realize that God can speak **AUDIBLY**.
