The Principles of Joy

Luke 15 (1-10)

Joy is expressed in how God **Supplies**

Joy is expressed in how God comforts us in **Suffering**

I. THE **SHEEP** in **Luke 15:4**

A. We are sheep

B. Sheep sometimes wander away from the fold—

Isaiah 53:6

C. Lost sheep have no place to rest—

Jeremiah 50:6

D. We are in need of a shepherd—

1 Peter 2:25

II. THE **SEARCH** in Luke 15:4

- A. The shepherd leaves his flock to go find the lost sheep.
- B. Christ, as the Good Shepherd, searches for lost sheep.
- C. That was His whole purpose in coming—

Luke 19:10

D. He loves us like we were His only sheep-

III. THE **SUPPORT** in Luke 15:5

- A. The shepherd took the sheep in his arms and carried it.
- B. Jesus will take us in His arms and carry us to safety -

Matthew 11:28

C. He has promised to never leave us nor forsake us

IV THE **SHOUT** in Luke 15:5b-6

A. "Shout" = "Leaping, Dancing, Rejoicing"-

Psalm 107:1-2

- B. The shepherd rejoiced
- C. The friends and neighbors rejoiced

V THE **SALVATION** in **Luke 15:7**

- A. "Joy shall be in heaven"
- B. The redeemed in heaven rejoice over a sinner that repents---a lost sheep that comes home.
