

Psalm 73 in Context:

When it seems that the **WICKED** are prospering and the faithful believer is **SINKING**.

Where are the Christians who have not struggled with this same problem? Righteous people seem pressed down on every side, often struggling with the necessities of life; whereas, openly arrogant and wicked non-believers walk around parading their godless lives.

This just doesn't seem right, and many healthy, strong and committed Christians are left CONFUSED. How do you handle situations like this?

- 1. Share what's going on in your heart
 - Even Christians struggle with doubt and confusion when God's truth seems to contradict their present condition.
 - Always be HONEST with your reality.
- 2. Think <u>Carefully</u> when facing life's challenges
 - Your decisions have a DIRECT impact on those around you.
 - Don't let your issue cause you to act out of EMOTIONS or out of CHARACTER –

Proverbs 17:28; James 1:19-20

- 3. Always focus on the Larger view
 - What you see will determine what you feel.
